VEGETABLES AND FRUIT

Class

1. Three potatoes- WHITE – of any shape
2. Three potatoes – COLOURED – of any shape
3. Three potatoes – any SALAD variety
4. Three carrots – any variety
5. Three beetroot – any variety
6. Three onions – trimmed & tied
7. Six shallots – trimmed & tied
8. Six runner beans
9. Six French beans (dwarf or climbing)
10. Six pods of peas
11. Two courgettes – with approximately 1” of stem
12. Six stems of parsley – any variety
13. Four kinds of culinary herbs – two stems of each – displayed in a vase
14. Six tomatoes – small fruiting variety – ripened – on a plate
15. Six tomatoes – other variety – ripened – on a plate
16. Two cucumbers – with approximately 1” of stem
17. Three stems of Swiss chard – full leaf – same or mixed colours
18. Any vegetable not previously mentioned; small veg (eg chilli peppers) up to 3 specimens
19. Three stems of rhubarb
20. A collection of garden produce displayed on a tray provided (size 12” x 20”)
21. Any soft fruit – up to three varieties – on a small plate
22. Any other fruit – three of one kind

VEGETABLES (OPEN CLASSES)

23. A wonky vegetable
24. An animal made out of fruit and vegetables (for adults AND children)
25. Longest runner bean
26. Heaviest potato (clean please)
