CUT FLOWERS

Class

27. Five pansies or violas – on a card
28. Five stems of marigolds or calendulas – any type
29. Sweet peas – three colours – three stems of each
30. Sweet peas – one colour – five stems
31. Three clematis – any kind – may use own vase
32. Three stems of roses – bush, standard, or climbing – multi headed
33. Three stems of roses – bush, standard, or climbing – single headed
34. Best specimen of rose – single bloom
35. Five stems of rudbeckia – any kind
36. Five stems of dahlias – any kind
37. Five stems of annuals – one kind – not previously mentioned
38. One vase of annuals – three kinds – three stems of each – not previously mentioned
39. Five stems of perennial flowers – one kind – not mentioned in other classes
40. One vase of perennial flowers – three kinds – three stems of each - not mentioned in other classes
41. Three stems of flowering shrubs (not roses) – can be mixed
42. Three spikes of gladioli – can be mixed colours
43. Three stems of sunflowers – any colour – single or multi headed

TERRY MEAKIN TROPHY

44. 5 stems of zinnias

CUT FLOWERS (OPEN CLASS)

45. A display of garden flowers in your own vase – annuals and/or perennials - no more than SIX varieties.

POT PLANTS (Maximum pot size 10” inside rim)

46. One tuberous begonia – in flower
47. One non-tuberous begonia – in flower
48. One pelargonium – geranium – zonal or scented leaf – flowering
49. One fuchsia plant – flowering
50. One flowering house plant – not mentioned in other classes
51. One foliage house plant
52. Exotic plant (eg.Orchid)
53. A pot of cacti or succulents – one kind or mixed
